(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as "Parties" and individually as "Party")

WHEREAS

- A. First Party is a Higher Education Institute Named:

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations. The parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 The co-operation between First Party and Second Party will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the Second Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching/ training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the First Party.
- 1.3 The general tears of co-operation shall be governed by this MoU. The parties shall cooperation with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the "Definitive Documents") as maybe required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MoU. Along with the definitive documents, this MoU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

CLAUSE 2 SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 2.1 Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be a major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 2.2 The Second Party will give valuable inputs to the first Party in teaching/training methodology so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
- 2.3 The interaction between Industry and Institution will give an insight into the latest developments/requirements of the industries; The Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its collaborated companies and also involve in Industrial Training Programs for the First Party. The industrial training and exposure provided to students through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. The Second Party will provide its Labs/Workshops/Industrial sites for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party.
- 2.4 The Second Party will train the students of the First Party on the emerging trends in order to bridge the gap in skill and make them ready for industry.

- 2.5 The Second Party will extend the necessary support to deliver guest lecturers to the students of the First Party on the emerging areas and in-house requirements.
- 2.6 The Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the training and placement of students of the First Party in to internships/jobs.
- 2.7 The Second Party will train the faculty of First Party for imparting training as per the statutory authority requirements.

CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

3.1 Nothing contained in this MoU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-now, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE 4 GENERAL TERMS AND PROVISIONS OF MoU

- 4.1 Duration and Termination of Agreement: MOU shall be effective from the date of signing and shall remain in force for a period of three years i.e. 03.01.2022 to 03.01.2025. It shall automatically be renewed for next three years with the understanding that the appropriate authorities of either Party may terminate this MoU with a written notice to the other Party ,one month before termination. The agreement may be amended by mutual written consent of both the Parties. This MoU is written and signed in two identical copies in English with one copy with both the Parties.
- **4.2** Coordination and Periodic Review: In order to carryout and fulfill the aims of this agreement, each Party will appoint an appropriate person(s) to represent its organization and to coordinate the implementation of activities. Both Parties shall meet regularly (preferably with two days' notice) to discuss progress of planned activities.
- **4.3 Financial Arrangement**: There is no financial commitment on the part of the First Party to take up any Programme mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be deal separately.
- **4.4 Communications**: All notices, demands and other communication under this agreement in connection herewith shall be written in English language and shall be sent to the last known address, e-mail, or fax of the concerned company. Any notice shall be effective from the date on which it reaches the other party.
- **4.5** Addendum: Any Addendum to this MoU shall be in writing and signed by both parties.
- 4.6 Force Majeure: The Parties shall not be liable for any failure to perform any of its obligation under this MoU if the performance is prevented, hindered or by reason of war, or hostility, acts of the public enemy, civic commotion, sabotage, act of state or direction from Statutory Authority, explosion, epidemic, quarantine restriction, strikes and lookouts (as are not limited to the establishments and facilities of Accurate labs), fire, floods, natural calamities or any act of God (hereinafter referred to as event), provided notice of happening of any such events given by the

affected party to the other, within 21 calendar days from the date of occurrence thereof, neither party shall, by reason of such event, be entitles to terminate the MoU, nor shall either party have any such claims for damage against the other, in respect of such non-performance or delay in performance. Provided service under the MoU shall be resumed as soon as practicable, after such event comes is an end or ceases to exist. Each party shall promptly inform the other of the existence of Force Majeure event and shall consult together to find a mutually acceptable solution.

4.7 Arbitration: In the event of a dispute between the both Parties arising out of, or relating to this Agreement, its interpretation or performance hereunder, the parties shall exert their best efforts to resolve dispute amicably though negotiations. In case of any disagreement and dispute and the parties fail to mutually resolve the issue; both parties shall appoint an Arbitrator is mutually agreeable and shall be settled as per Indian Arbitration Act. Further, in case the parties failed to resolve the dispute; this agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the law within the state of Andhra Pradesh, India.

The general terms and provisions in this MOU also apply to any subsequent Addendum to this agreement.

- 4. Terms and conditions:
- A. The faculty members and students can use the library on mutual basis for short time use.

- C. Both the institutes can exchange the faculty as resource person in order to exchange knowledge.

5. Confidentiality:

- A. Consorted institutes agree to hold in confidence all information/data designed by the institutes as being confidential during the rendition of MOU and will not disclose the same to the third party without written consent of the other institute.
- B. The above confidential clause under this MOU excludes the information / data possessed by either institute before entering this MOU or independently developed and/or information already available through public domain.

6. Coordination:

A. Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching / research faculty to coordinate the program on its behalf.

7. Intellectual Property Rights:

A. Institutes agree to respect each other's right to intellectual property. The Intellectual property Rights that arise as a result of joint research and collaborative activity under the agreement will be worked out on a case-to-case basis and will be consistent with officially laid down IPR Policies of the two institutes.

8. Tenure and termination:

- A. This MOU will be in force from the date up to **One year** it is signed by representatives of two institutions.
- B. The agreement will be legitimacy for a period of 1 year from the day of signing of this agreement, until it is expressed terminated by either party on mutually agreed terms, as the case may be; will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU.

Formation and terms of reference

The joint committee will approve the biennial work plan, monitor and evaluate the cooperation activities carried out.

Biennial work plans

The parties will jointly prepare Biennial Work Plans (hereinafter referred to as in BWP) after approval of this MoU. The biennial work plan will set out specific co- operation activities to be carried out in each biennium.

Each BWP will include a detailed planning for carrying out of the co-operation activities including objectives. Scope of the action, assignment of resources, projected costs and their distribution, time schedule and any other information deemed necessary.

Each BWP does not necessarily need to include activities in all of the co-operation areas specified in "Title 2" of this MoU.

Funding

The implementation of each activity under this MoU shall be subjected to the availability of the required funds in the annual budgets which the respective parties have available for co-operation activities. In case the Volksphantom IP Solutions Pvt Ltd. the activities will be financed from the available funds under the plan scheme developed by **KVSRSCOPS**.

Final Provisions

• Entry into Force

This MoU will enter into force on the day following the date of its signature

Amendments

This MolU may be amended by mutual agreement by the parties, formalized by an exchange of letters specifying the date of entry into force.

Settlement of Disputes

Any dispute which may arise in connection with the interpretation or enforcement of this MoU shall be settled by mutual consultation and agreement between the parties.

Duration and termination

 - the VPC can establish by reasonable proof that, was in the possession of the KVSR SCOPS at the time of disclosure and was not acquired directly or indirectly from VPC;
 - d) becomes known to the VPC from a third party which has lawful access to such information and which may disclose the information without any obligation to KVSR SCOPS; or with KVSR SCOPS written permission, may be required for obtaining essential or desirable authorizations or rights relating to the Products from governmental authorities or as otherwise required by law.

e) The parties agree to keep confidential and not to disclose to any other person, firm or entity this Agreement and discussions hereunder unless the other party gives its prior written consent to such disclosure.

C. The term of confidentiality clause would be 2 years

Each party designates the single point of contact person (SPOC), Dr.P.Srinivasa Babu Professor & Principal, Vignan Pharmacy College from FIRST PARTY and Dr.A.Suneetha Professor & Principal KVSR SCOPS.

9. Indemnity:

VPC hereby indemnifies and agrees to defend and hold harmless to the KVSR SCOPS. representatives, employees, shareholders, successors and assigns, from and against any and all losses, claims, damages, expenses or fees (including attorney's fees) arising out of or related to any injury, disability or death caused or alleged to have been caused as a direct and/or indirect result of the agreement, and any other costs and expenses incurred in connection therewith as set out in which KVSR SCOPS. may sustain or incur in any actions by any person, organization or governmental entity or agency or otherwise as a result of the performance, breach or nonperformance by VPC its agents, employees, representatives or assigns of VPC's obligations or duties under this Agreement.

Further, VPC faculty hereby agrees that it shall take all the responsibility for any loss, damage etc., on behalf of students being arranged in the scope of MOU. **KVSR SCOPS**.

shall not be responsible for the same.

10. Representations and Warranties:

Each of the Party represents and warrant that:

It has power to execute and enter into this Agreement and it has full right, capacity and authority to perform its obligations under this Agreement which when executed will constitute valid and binding obligations on it in accordance with its terms.

The entry and delivery of, and the performance by it of this Agreement will not result in any breach of any provision of applicable law, its constitutional documents, any other agreement and / or any court order, judgment, injunction,

award, decree or writ that is binding on it and / or its assets, or result in any claim by a third party against the other Party;

the execution and delivery of this Agreement and the actions contemplated hereby have been duly approved and authorized by all requisite actions and no other actions (corporate, statutory or otherwise) on its part are necessary.

- It has understood the terms of this Agreement and a copy of the Agreement has been provided to it;
- It has executed this Agreement of its free will and without relying on any statements made by the other Party or its representatives, agents or affiliates etc;
- The Agreement in respects is reasonable and necessary to protect the legitimate business interests of the Parties.

11. Force Majeure

Neither Party shall be held responsible for non-fulfillment of their respective obligations under this Agreement due to the exigency of one or more of the force majeure events such as but not limited to acts of God, war, flood earthquakes, strike, lockouts epidemics, riots, civil commotion, government action, riots etc. Provided on the occurrence and cessation of any such events, the Party affected thereby shall give a notice in writing to the other Party within one month of such occurrence or cessation. If the force-majeure condition continues beyond six months, the Parties shall then mutually decide about the future course of action.

12. Dispute Resolution

Any disputes and differences whatsoever arising under or in connection with this MoU which could not be settled by parties through negotiations, after the period of thirty(30) working days from the service of the notice, shall be finally settled by arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and the Amendment Act 2013. The parties will make reference for a sole arbitrator to be appointed by the parties in consultation with each other. The place of arbitration shall be at Vijayawada. Upon approval by each party, this agreement will remain in effect for the period of 2 years, unless terminated earlier by either institution.

Renewal period of this co-operation can be extended by mutual consent in writing by both the parties.
